How to Access: Directly in Blackboard, the Tutor.com link is located on the left-hand side or in the "Tools" section of any course.

#### What is my role in tutorial sessions?

- Arrive to tutorial appointment on time
- Be prepared with a laptop or Ipad (phones do not allow to share screens/files)
  - Be prepared with textbook, notebook, class notes, handouts, pen/pencil
- Come prepared with true attempt at assignments homework or quiz/test questions will not be answered directly; similar examples will be shown.
  - Be prepared to be engaged in the session practicing problems, explaining steps.
  - Be in a distraction-free environment: limit background noise such as music, people
