Some fidgets and communication sheets will be available in the lobby.

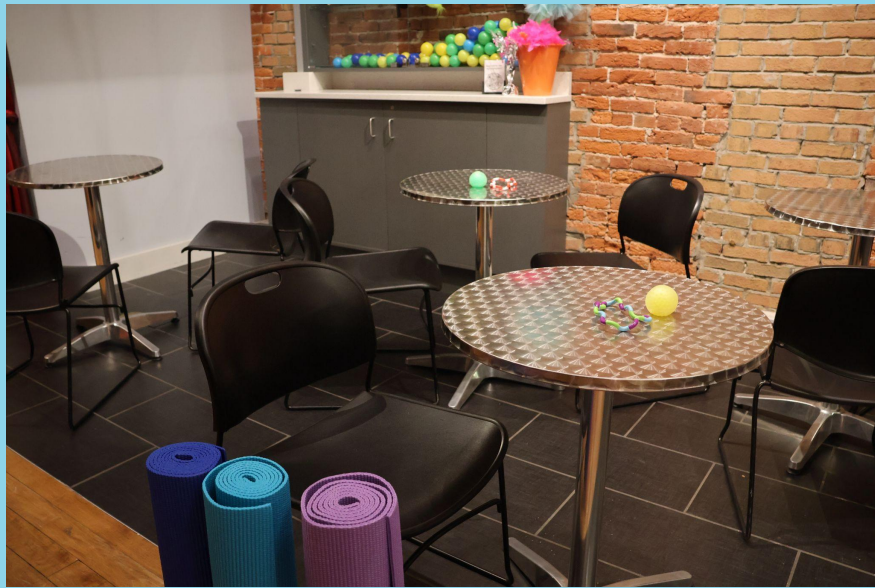


My seat number will be on my ticket. A volunteer will help my group find our seats.

After 2 scenes there will be a 15 minute intermission before the second half of the show.

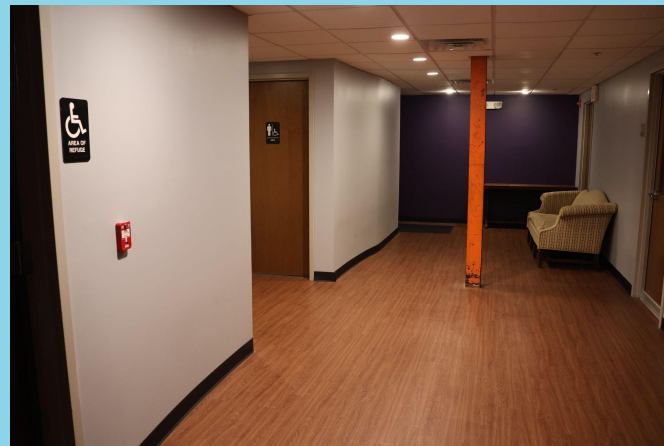
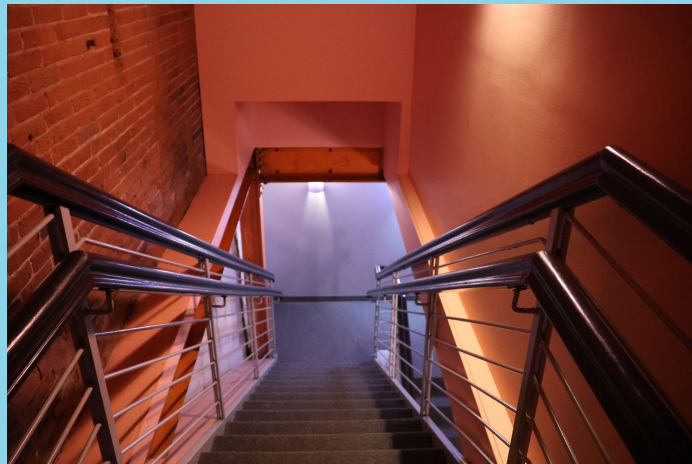
If I need to take a quiet break during the show before intermission, I can go to the lobby or one of the theater's "chill spaces".

About the Play



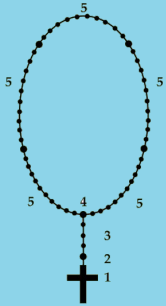
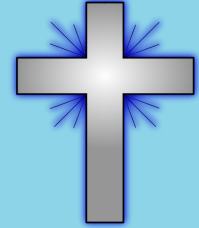
Nunsense A-Men is a musical farce comedy that follows the exact script of the original Nunsense musical but with men playing the nuns.

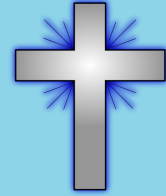
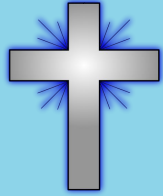
