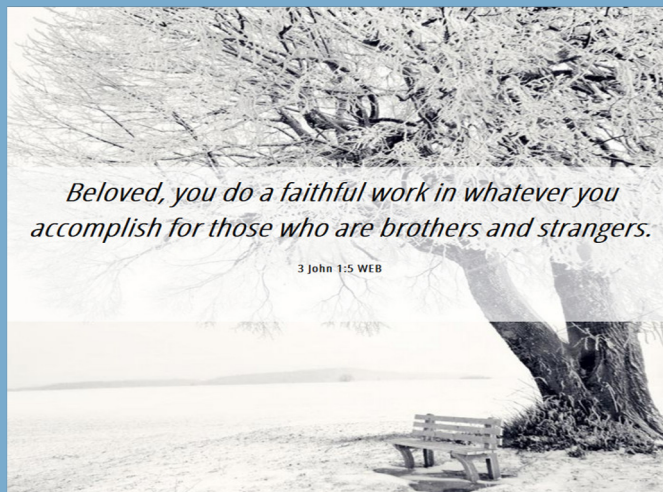

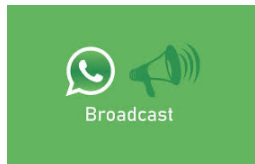
ASPC SAFETY MEASURES

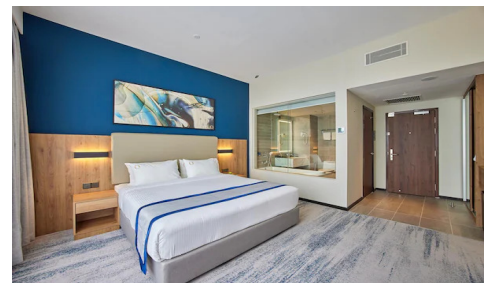
KEEP CLEAR OF SANCTUARY ENTRANCE

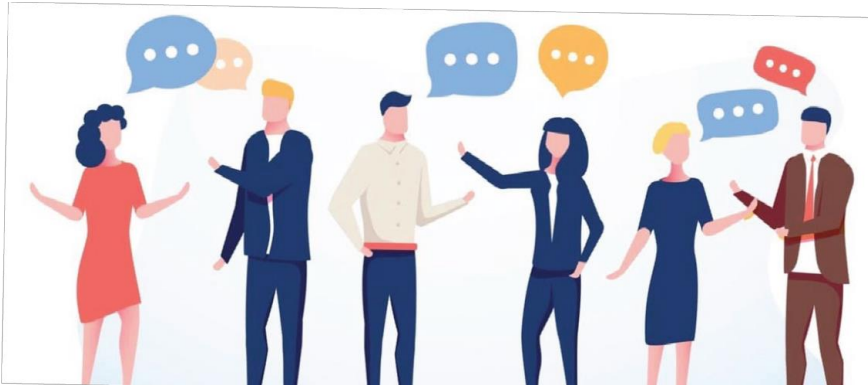
