Egg Stuffing 101

Unfortunately, the Easter Bunny doesn't bring thousands of candy filled eggs to Eggstravaganza. But that means we get to! So here's the simple rules to stuffing eggs for Eggstravaganza...

1) No Chocolate candy

While chocolate is yummy, it will melt in the eggs when they are sitting in the hot sun. So please use candy that won't melt during set-up!

2) Tape plastic eggs shut

Due to the transportation between churches and the event plus setting up the fields at the park, it's important not to forget to tape each plastic egg shut so that the candy doesn't fall out!

3) Where to bring stuffed eggs

Details will be coming in early March on drop-off dates at the churches. Placing bunches of eggs in plastic garabage bags is a great way to transport them! And if possible, use a marker on the side of the bag to note approx. how many candy filled eggs are in the bag!
